# **RITUALS AND TRADITIONS**



In the Christian tradition, blessing is a daily ritual. Martin Luther wrote the Small Catechism for the head of the household to teach the members of the household. There is a morning and evening blessing. Luther writes that we should make the sign of the cross when we get out of bed and when we go to bed.

Make the sign of the cross on your forehead or chest this week in the morning and in the evening and say: God the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit watch over me. Amen. (Small Catechism)
